## Rose of the Month

### Just Joey:    Hybrid Tea:    Orange Blend

Orange blend. Strong fragrance. 30 petals. Blooms in flushes throughout the season, occasional repeat later in the season.

Height of 30" to 4' (75 to 120 cm). Width of up to 4' (up to 120 cm).

USDA zone 7b through 10b. Spring Pruning: Remove old canes and dead or diseased wood and cut back canes that cross. In warmer climates, cut back the remaining canes by about one-third. In colder areas, you'll probably find you'll have to prune a little more than that. Requires spring freeze protection. Feed this rose well.
